The client approached Claire Garner Interiors to redesign their country home, hidden in a small picturesque village in Hertfordshire, surrounded by beautiful gardens. The house was filled with original rustic beams and this organic feel has been continued throughout the home. A neutral colour palette has been layered with faded warming pinks in the kitchen, and subtle tones of grey and green in the living room and master bedroom. Textiles and finishes were key to create the right atmosphere in each room, oversized pieces have been added such as the hallway mirror and the William Yeoward's inlaid console in the entrance to compliment the weight of the beams.
